
Moving ahead in our Journey to reach Zanskar, we take the offbeat road and cross Shinkula pass, situated at the height of 5,091 m.

Manali To Gumbok Rongjon




- Today we drive towards Gonbo Rongjon from the southern side of Zanskar.

Day-3




Gumbok Rongjon to Padum via Phugtal Monastery trek (3 km one side)

- Embrace the mountains with care. Pack a reusable bottle, limit plastic use, and bring back what you bring. Let's love and protect our mountains together.






Terms & conditions

- In hilly areas, scarcity of water and electricity is a natural phenomenon. To overcome the water crisis, certain hotels have fixed schedule for supplying hot and cold water. We strongly regret the inconvenience but do look forward to your cooperation.
- As imposed by the Government, a valid photo ID for all members staying at the hotel is mandatory.
- The camp accommodations at various places especially like Sarchu, Nubra and Pangong, Chandratal, Gumbok etc. are very basic even though they are classified into various categories.
- Due to unforeseen situations (force majeure/ traffic jams / traffic halts/ diversions/ curfew, Union strike, VVIP movement, etc.) the vehicle reporting may get delayed and in such case, we request you to bear with us. - No AC will be available in vehicles like Innova / Xylo / Scorpio ,Hilix ,Fortuner ,Thar ,Jimmny or any similar category in hilly regions.
- Kindly note that the Volvo from Delhi to Base is a third party vehicle provided by our listed vendors. Please understand that these are regular running vehicles and we cannot keep a proper check on them although in case of a break down a new vehicle is arranged but at times it takes a little while for the on-ground operations to do so thus, your cooperation i any breakdown happens is required.
- The Volvo bus halts for lunch/dinner wherever required are predefined by the vendor and cannot be changed by us as per our convenience.
